ARTICLE 12 - HOLIDAYS

- 12.1 <u>Scheduled Holidays:</u> The District agrees to provide all unit members with the following paid holidays provided they are in a paid status during any portion of the working day preceding or succeeding the holiday adopted according to the Board adopted calendar.
 - (1) New Year's Day
 - (2) Martin Luther King, Jr. Day
 - (3) Lincoln's Birthday
 - (4) Washington's Birthday
 - (5) Spring Vacation Day
 - (6) Memorial Day
 - (7) Independence Day
 - (8) Labor Day
 - (9) Floating Holiday*
 - (10) Admission Day**
 - (11) Veteran's Day
 - (12) Thanksgiving Day and Day Following
 - (13) Christmas Day and Day Before
 - The floating holiday may be taken on birthday, during Christmas or Spring recess or at a time approved in advance by the immediate supervisor and may only be taken after six months of employment.
 - ** Admission Day shall be observed adjacent to New Year's Day and mutually agreed upon prior to adoption of the District Calendar.
- Additional Holidays: Any days appointed by the President or Governor of this State as a public fast, mourning, thanksgiving, or holiday shall be a paid holiday, provided schools are required to close as per Education Code 37220. In addition, any other day designated as a holiday by the Governing Board of the District.
- 12.3 <u>Holidays on Saturday or Sunday:</u> When a holiday falls on a Saturday, the preceding Friday shall be deemed that holiday. When a holiday falls on a Sunday, the following Monday shall be deemed to be that holiday.
- 12.4 <u>Holiday Eligibility:</u> Except as otherwise provided in this Article, a unit member must be in paid status on the working day immediately preceding or succeeding the holiday to be paid for the holiday.
 - 12.4.1 Unit members who are not normally assigned to duty during the school holidays of December 25 or January 1 shall be paid for those holidays provided that they were in paid status during the working day of their normal assignment immediately preceding or succeeding the holiday period.
